SEVENTH SUNDAY OF EASTER ([B])**World Communication Day****13th May 2018 – Parish Mass Book page 273**

This weekend marks the memorial of two martyrs from the sixteenth century. Saturday is the feast of St. John Houghton, a Carthusian, and Prior of the London Charterhouse, martyred in 1535. Sunday would be the feast day of Blessed John Beche, the last Abbot of St. John's in Colchester, martyred in the town in 1539. Why mention them? Quite simply, they died for the true faith. We hear a lot today about, 'fake news'; it isn't new. So much of what is commonly accepted as 'true' about the so-called Reformation in England is fake news. In this Sunday's Gospel Jesus prays, '...keep those you have given me true to your name' and again, '...the world hated them.' These two men died for remaining faithful to the name of Jesus. Thomas More in the Tower and himself soon to die a martyr's death, seeing St. John and his companions going to their deaths, exclaimed to his daughter, 'Look, Meg! These blessed Fathers be now as cheerfully going to their deaths as bridegrooms to their marriage.' May we remain as faithful and as cheerful, despite challenges and difficulties.
