In his parables, Jesus generally takes situations familiar to the people of his day and then often brings in an unexpected variation, challenging the hearers to reflect and discern the teaching itself. So it is in today's passage, the method of seating at banquets would have been well-known, but Jesus turns the custom on its head because he is focussed on true humility rather than merely human ideas of honour. He then takes things further, raising more questions for us to answer. Thus, instead of holding banquets which most likely would be taken up with human pride, he is suggesting we focus on looking after those in need – the regular meals in the Cardinal Bourne hall, and the contributions to the local food-bank, would be examples of how we locally are seeking to put his teaching into practice.
