The readings this week address what is usually called the second coming, actually it will be the third - the first is at Bethlehem, the second is now in the Church, the third is at the end of time. This final and full coming of Jesus will be in power and majesty. At the end of the Apocalypse, itself the last book of the Bible, God declares, 'Now I make the whole of creation new'. Today's readings look at changes in the physical world. I think we ought to consider also how the saints will be changed, something we don't perhaps think about very much. Those found worthy of a place in the communion of saints will be glorified in body and soul, immortal. In this part of our life here on earth we are only too aware of our bodily and spiritual frailty, a glorified person will be in perfect harmony with God and therefore themselves and all the other saints. Pope Francis is asking us to be Pilgrims of Hope, people who trust in God's promises and look forward in hope to the fulfilment of those promises in themselves. I would suggest each of us spends a little time trying to imagine what it will be like as an immortal being in body and soul, even a fuzzy idea ought to make us yearn for heaven more than the things of this world.
