FIFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (C)

Week Commencing 9th February 2025

The Gospel tells the story of Jesus calling His first disciples. Simon Peter and his companions had been fishing all night without success. When Jesus tells them to cast their nets again, they obeydespite their doubts-and catch so many fish that their nets nearly break. Overwhelmed, Peter falls at Jesus' feet, recognizing His divine power. Jesus then calls them to a new mission: to become fishers of men. They leave everything behind and follow Him. This passage reminds us of the power of obedience and trust in the Lord. Even when our own efforts seem not to be yielding results, God can bring abundance when we listen to Him. Peter's reaction, humility and awe, teaches us how to respond to Christ's presence in our lives. As followers of Christ, we are also called to be fishers of men, sharing the Gospel and bringing others to Jesus. Like Peter and his friends, we may feel unworthy, but Jesus sees beyond our weaknesses and calls us anyway. Let us trust in Him, cast our nets in faith. God's grace is always greater than our doubts.
