PALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD [A]

PALM SUNDAY for us Christians is the commemoration of the entrance of Jesus into Jerusalem. This event, replete with many significant events in the life of Jesus, calls us to see in us our being disciples in light of our faith's journey.

This last joyful entrance of Jesus is a journey which gives us a clear picture of how he answered to the voice of his Father. Indeed, he is telling us that "this is it", i.e., the ultimate expression of his obedience to him has come in order to prove his love not only to his "Abba", Father, through to us by dying through total self-offering on the Cross.

Sometimes seeing what is happening in this world, we are tempted to think that Jesus' total self-offering wasn't good enough. We seem to have been overcome by it. Many would think that parents are incapable of their duty as parents, priests are scarce and inadequate, friendship is so vulnerable, family has collapsed and what the world offers us is not sufficient to meet our needs...everything else is a disaster. But what do we really want in life? What Jesus did for us was already the "maximum"; his whole self. Nothing is left to him! Now, isn't more than enough yet?

In this coming Holy Week let us meditate again and consider more deeply and seriously the love and mercy of God for humanity. And let us join him in his way to the cross with humility, so that we may awaken once again in us how much Jesus love us.

The Son of God gave himself to us totally without reserve. Believe in him, he is the only one who gave us enough in order to have life here on earth reach its fulfilment. Let us sing together "HOSANA to the King of kings.
