A phrase many people may be using in these days is, How can I spend my time? At the Easter Vigil the Paschal candle, representing Christ the light of the world, is marked up and one phrase spoken by the priest is, All time belongs to Him. A timely reminder that it is in God's world that we live. It doesn't mean we have to be on our knees praying 24/7, though time for formal prayer is of course still needed; it's more a matter of doing all things in Christ. So whatever you are doing to 'pass the time', I would propose that it is done 'within the will of God' so that all time does indeed belong to Christ and thereby becomes a moment of grace and growth. In effect, these challenging days can become more clearly a kind of retreat, a pilgrimage (even without leaving home!). We're very conscious of parishioners when we are celebrating the liturgies of Easter, praying for you. The Bishop's letter is encouraging, please read it. Easter is the celebration of Christ's victory over sin and death, may you be blessed this year in particular.

Fr. Nixon/ I will continue to offer Mass each day at 8.15_{am} (Monday – Saturday) and 10.00_{am} on Sunday, with the intentions published in the newsletter, and daily exposition from 7_{pm}-8_{pm}.

On a practical note, Mass intentions can be posted through the letter box of 51, Priory Street and will be published in the newsletter which will be available on the parish website.

For Baptisms, Weddings and Funerals, please contact our parish office. We can still visit for the Sacrament of the Sick, with suitable precautions.

Also, the parish continues to incur expenses. Several parishioners have made their weekly offering, sometimes in an envelope hand-delivered, others have posted cheques. Thank you. Gift Aid envelopes for the new financial year will be delivered to your home. Parishioners may wish to set up a standing order, our parish office can help.

The collection on Good Friday, for the Holy Places, is transferred to the Feast of the Exaltation of the Cross, September 14th.

Please see our website for details of the Indulgence available to parishioners for joining in prayerfully while we are celebrating in church.

There is also a new Proper Mass for use in the time of a pandemic which will be celebrated soon after Easter (it cannot be used in Holy week or the Easter Octave).
