**FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER [A] -**

May 14<sup>th</sup> 2017 – Parish Mass Book 265

The fifth Sunday of Easter is characterized as a joyful thanksgiving for the very reason that Jesus is alive and present still even up today, tomorrow and forever.

In the Gospel, we read this line "If you know me, then you will also know my Father". Jesus answered Philip this way when he queried about his relationship with his Father. Jesus also gave words of consolation as he is about to leave them orphans. Furthermore, Jesus added this phrase at the end "do not let your hearts be troubled".

The Gospel is clearly saying that we cannot know the Father if we do not know Jesus. It is only through Jesus that we can approach the "Abba", for they are one.

Brothers and sisters, we are Christians precisely because Christ is non-negotiable for us. That is why Christ must always be at the centre of our prayers. We cannot get rid of him, as in the Liturgy and in the Sacraments, especially in the Eucharist. He must be the centre of our Christian life always. The Jews and Muslims pray straight to God without acknowledging Jesus as the Father's only begotten Son. We Christians, however, do recognize in him, his oneness with his Father.

If this is our Faith, let us reflect and preach this Truth always. And let us not allow our hearts be troubled with anything and anybody. He is our Good Shepherd; he is truly the one! Pray always that you may increase in faith, hope and love. Finally, say the prayer which St. Philip uttered, "Master, show us the Father". **Fr. Alex,rcj**
