# SIXTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (B) WEEK COMMENCING 21<sup>ST</sup> JULY 2024

The passage from the Gospel of Mark <sup>(6:30-34)</sup> reveals the compassionate heart of Jesus as a shepherd for his flock. After the apostles returned from their mission, Jesus invites them to "come away by yourselves to a lonely place and rest a while." However, the crowds followed them, and Jesus, "seeing the great crowd, had compassion on them, because they were like sheep without a shepherd." Today's Gospel passage highlights the deep empathy and care that Jesus has for the people. Rather than turning them away, he responds with compassion, teaching them many things. The image of Jesus as the Good Shepherd who seeks out the lost and tends to the weary is a powerful one. It reveals the heart of God, who desires to gather his people, heal their wounds, and lead them to abundant life. This compassion of Christ is a model for all who are called to shepherd and care for God's people.
