SECOND COLLECTION THIS WEEKEND: The final Diocesan Second Collection for 2017 will take place this Sunday – National Youth Sunday and Feast of Christ the King.

BISHOP'S CERTIFICATE in Catechesis & Youth Ministry [BC]: is designed to be an entry level qualification to help in the ongoing formation of youth leaders in parishes and catechists involved in preparing young people for First Holy Communion and Confirmation in the Diocese of Brentwood. It includes both the development of practical skills and the deepening of theological knowledge. The course fee is £25 which includes access to all online videos and downloadable resources accessed through a personal login via the website. There is also a requirement for students to attend 2 study days, normally on a Saturday. The first year of the BC will serve as a pilot and, as such, only able to have an intake of 20-30 people. The first cohort begins in January 2018; the second cohort can begin in April 2018.
