WEEK COMMENCING: 31ST MAY 2020 - PARISH MASS BOOK PAGE

Pentecost is the one of the most important feast days of the year, the beginnings of the Church. At Pentecost, the Holy Spirit came upon the Apostles, Mary and the followers who were gathered in the Upper Room in prayer (Acts 1: 12-14). "He had told them not to leave Jerusalem, but to wait there for what the Father had promised." The Holy Spirit endowed the apostles with gifts to carry out this commission.

St. Paul in his letter to the church in Corinth writes as if such gifts of the Holy Spirit were a common place in the early church (1Cor 12: 7-11). The early church had many problems as the church has now. In fact, the church in Corinth had a fair share of its challenges.

What would the Church be like if it was vibrant with the Holy Spirit? After the Ascension of Jesus into heaven, Jesus took his seat at the right side of the Father and poured out the Holy Spirit on the Church. Let us ask Jesus to continue to pour out the Holy Spirit on the Church today.
